

This Licence is subject to the terms and conditions in the *Ship Radio Licence and Ship Portable Radio Licence Conditions Booklet*. A **Ship Radio Licence** authorises the Licensee to establish, install and use radio transmitting and receiving equipment as indicated in the table below, on board the vessel detailed above.

A **Ship Portable Radio Licence** is intended for use in United Kingdom territorial waters and authorises the Licensee to establish, install and use radio transmitting and receiving equipment as indicated in the table below.
